MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Amending the penal law to allow the possession of firearms on property owned or held in trust for the SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry.

The NYSCC supports this legislation. Due to changes in the law enacted under the SAFE Act, SUNY ESF was forced to close to firearms hunting over 5,000 acres of land under its administration but which it did not own.

The SAFE Act makes possession of a firearm on property used for educational purposes a felony. While the law allowed an exemption for land owned by SUNY ESF, it did not apply to several thousand acres of land held in trust for SUNY ESF. This land has been used by students and faculty, as well as the public, for research and recreational hunting on a regular basis.

'In trust for' land and 'owned' land are managed in the same manner and are, for all practical purposes, indistinguishable.

This bill would include the "in trust for" land with the "owned by" property, allowing the same treatment for the purposes of the firearms law.
